JANUARY

- **FAFSA**
  - <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>
  - This is not a scholarship site. Rather it is a site to fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The information from the FAFSA is used to determine “financial need.” This is a very important form to fill out.
  - If the student is a non-married, non-parent, undergraduate student under the age of 25, parent information is required to complete this form.
  - This should be filled out as soon as W-2 forms are sent home and taxes are done. It can be filled out on January 1st with estimated numbers, but once taxes are done, you must correct the estimated numbers.

  - Minimum Eligibility: Asian and/or Pacific Islander ethnicity; Be a citizen, national, or legal permanent resident of the US; Enrolled in a US accredited college/university in the Fall of 2014; Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 or have earned a GED; Must apply for federal financial aid using FAFSA; Submit one letter of recommendation online.

  - Eligibility: Be a current UH student at any of the 10 campuses
  - Requirements: Completed FAFSA; Official Transcripts; Letters of Recommendation; Personal Statement; Essay(s)

  - Requirements: Official transcript. Letters of Recommendation; Completed FAFSA (as required); Personal statement; Meet any special requirements specific to the scholarships listed online (each scholarship has unique criteria).

  - Eligibility: Preference to students of Hawaiian or part-Hawaiian ancestry; Enrollment full-time in an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher education; High school seniors or college students may apply; Community service or volunteer work is highly desirable. Scholarship awards vary from \$500-\$1000 per award.

  - Eligibility: Be a Hawai'i resident; Be a full-time student (there may exception for non-traditional students for part-time status); Be a classified, degree-seeking student at an accredited educational institution in the U.S.; Have financial need as demonstrated in the completed CSS/PROFILE application; Meet maximum funding guidelines as listed.

  - Deadline: April
  - Selection Criteria: Financial need; Socially, physically, and economically challenged adults; Displaced households with small children.
  - Eligibility: Clearly define career goals/objectives; Specify educational requirements to attain goals; Utilize re-entry programs; U.S. Citizen; 18 yrs or older.

  - Eligibility: Be of Hawaiian ancestry; Be a Hawaii or US Continent resident; Be an undergraduate or graduate student; Demonstrate financial need or academic merit; Be enrolled full-time or part-time in accredited two- or four-year college; meet the minimum GPA requirement (2.0 undergraduate; 3.0 graduate).
  - Tip – Start compiling the following required documentation:
    - Complete 2014 FAFSA; Retrieve the Student Aid Report (SAR)
    - Request official transcript from your current institution
    - Provide proof of ancestry with an OHA registry card or birth certificate
